Rogue Government Rogue President

I first published the following Black Eye News Item in April of 2007. This should be talked about a lot in the coming months, but I can assure you it will not be discussed in the proper context. After you read it, you can read what I have to add.

UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE, US of A STYLE

There are verbal rumbblings among some presidential candidates about “universal health coverage.” Hillary Clinton, for one, is serious about making universal health coverage a reality in the US of A. The problem is this: universal health coverage does not mean the same in white power America as it does in a non-capitalist country.

There was a time not long ago when it was legal for anyone with a driver’s license and a car to drive anywhere s/he wanted to. But people began realizing that moving cars posed a threat to the public, so it was decided that vehicle owners needed to have the means to compensate others when their vehicle damaged someone else’s person or property. What came out of that realization is what we call mandatory car insurance. Mandatory car insurance is a golden goose for the insurance and health care industries, but the concept has merit.

We could easily call mandatory car insurance “universal car coverage.” When white power America approves a universal health coverage program, it will function pretty much like mandatory car insurance functions. The federal and state governments will not be required to provide health coverage to all of its citizens (which is how a universal health program should work), but all of its citizens WILL BE REQUIRED TO spend part of their money on a health insurance policy. It, like mandatory car insurance, will be a golden goose for the insurance and health care industries. But, unlike mandatory car insurance (which only applies to those who decide to drive), individuals have no way of sidestepping the expenditure. The government will force everybody to give part of their paycheck to an insurance company, whether individuals think the better of it or not.

Universal health care, US of A style, will mean the citi-

zens of the US will have less control over their income. As it stands now, people in the US control only around 2/3 of the money they earn (the remainder is taken from them in the form of taxes by one name here and taxes by another name there). Universal health care, US of A style, will be like a tax by another name. It’s going to help some people here and there, but more often than not, it’s going to generate financial restrictions that make people sick.

Among a revolutionary people, logic can take a back seat as other factors, other intangibles, take them toward status quo shattering possibilities. Unfortunately, people who are not revolutionary can fall prey to emotions and other intangibles that further their victimization. This seems to be the case with Black People in the United States. How else could supposedly intelligent Black individuals get so enthused over the prospect of having a Black person elected president of a white power country as roguish as this?

The United States government is a rogue government. It is not illegitimate because it is what its core group wanted it to be, but it is a rogue because it is a constant menace; to human progress, to progressive leadership and leaders throughout the world, to democracy, justice, equal opportunity, to the prospect of people enjoying life rather than enduring it. The United States government has done more harm than any government in the history of humankind. And, contrary to what so many people want to believe, it was designed to be exactly what it is.

So the problem with universal health care, Hillary Clinton style, is that it is proposed within a rogue context, a capitalist context. But that will not be mentioned when discussions arise over Hillary Clinton’s “cure” for the country’s uninsured. Sadly, Americans are not quite smart enough to ask themselves why a poor country like Cuba can provide health care to all of its people free of charge, but a rich country like the United States can not afford to so likewise.

It would take a revolution of white America’s masses to change the United States, and that is not likely to happen. Staggered year elections in the senate and the house, life time appointments of supreme court justices, unwarranted respect for a rogue constitution, an abundance of

citizens and officials who can be bought off by big business, a poorly educated and purchase driven population; all of these combat against working within the system to generate worthwhile changes. Regardless of who is president, the status quo's roguish essence is here to stay because it is built into this country's fabric.

What difference did it make when Indira Ghandi or Margaret Thatcher was elected president of their respective country? What difference did it make when Anwar Sadat was elected president of Egypt, Douglas Wilder governor of Virginia or any of a host of Blacks as mayors of major cities? Even if some of them had wanted to make revolutionary type changes, they would have been unable to do so because white power America knows how to use its system to frustrate mavericks and eliminate genuine representatives of progress.

Black People in the United States, so called African Americans, can't seem to get beyond the grip of white power America. They keep spinning their wheels in a mud hole, and when a little extra color is added to that mud hole's mix, African Americans spin their wheels even harder. What a pity.
