A WORD OR TWO THE WORST IS YET TO COME

The following was reported in the Washington Post (10/04/06, Business Section):

“U.S. antitrust authorities yesterday approved a plan by Lockheed Martin Corp. and Boeing Co. to merge their government rocket businesses, creating a monopoly in a multibillion-dollar market that the Federal Trade Commission acknowledged will probably lead to higher prices and lower quality.”

Some people will think this is an aberration, a quirk in white America's economic system, since they have been taught that capitalism promotes competition within any given market. But capitalism has never been about promoting competition; capitalism has never been about free enterprise. Capitalism is and always has been about eliminating competition and monopolizing markets. On page 87 of my book *An Introduction to White History: The History of White America*, I spelled this out quite clearly. I wrote, “...capitalism resembles free enterprise but is, in fact, its complete opposite. Capitalism does not operate within the confines of a free enterprise market economy. Quite to the contrary, capitalism is characterized by eliminating the competition, which, in turn, eliminates the free market.”

The Lockheed Martin - Boeing monopoly will not only lead to higher prices (your tax dollars) and lower quality, as the people at the Federal Trade Commission acknowledge, it will expedite a general quality of life decline throughout the United States. Other industries will follow the monopoly path, and

that is bad news because “...capitalism cares little about satisfying the consumer in a way that is palatable to the consumer. Without the proper restraints, it would enslave the mass of consumers, subject them to a general state of poverty and, eventually, either crumble under the weight of its own vices or generate levels of inequity and iniquity that could undermine all forms of human organization.” (p. 87)

For all intents and purposes, there are no constraints on capitalism in the United States. It would be expected that the government would impose the needed restraints, but the government itself supports the “inequities and iniquities” of a capitalistic system and has been morphed into a capitalistic entity. In order to make sure it becomes all that it can be, capitalism attempts to conquer or destroy not only economic forces that oppose it, but social, political and religious forces as well.

That is why I continued with the following (page 186): “Capitalism was conceived in Europe and spent much of its infancy there, but it was the bosom of white America that zealously nourished capitalism and handled it with kid gloves... While white America nursed capitalism and protected it from its detractors, capitalism propelled white America's growth, multiplied white America's riches and, characteristically, made white America in its own image. White America became the epitome, the living embodiment, of an all-consuming economic ideology. Its self-absorption, narcissism and lack


of scruples drove white America to pursue what it wanted by whatever means imaginable; hook or crook, intrigue or misdeed, murder or unjustified military action. Its de-prioritizing of people and humane considerations is so blatant that it causes humanitarians to shudder, and its detachment from qualities such as justice and fair play is as total as it can be at any given time.”

With the monopolizing of industries in the United States, the everyday American will bear the brunt of capitalism’s self absorption, lack of scruples and detachment from qualities such as fair play and justice. At last, the everyday American will feel the full effect of white America’s hooks and crooks, intrigues and misdeeds, murders and, yes, military actions. Just as in banana republics and dictatorships, where the primary function of the army is to control the general population, white America’s armed forces will increasingly be carrying out a higher percentage of its deployment activities against American citizens and residents.

When Africans were kidnapped, murdered, enslaved, forced to work for free and victimized by nonstop misinformation campaigns, capitalism was running the show but refused to show its face. When Native Americans were killed, robbed of their land, scalped, impoverished and victimized by nonstop misinformation campaigns, capitalism was running the show but refused to show its face. With the invasion of Iraq, capitalism has started stepping to the forefront. Those who benefit big time from capitalism believe everyday people have become so enamored of it that they would rather suffer with it than do good without it. So prepare for worse and worse times.
